

Home Energy Review Preparation

A home energy review is a thorough assessment of the efficiency of your home. In order to do a complete assessment, your energy specialist will need access to all areas of your home, including living rooms, bedrooms, closets, the attic and basement/crawlspace.

Please follow the steps outlined below to prepare for your Home Energy Review:

- Clear areas in attic and basement to allow access to your home heating systems, AC units and water heater(s).
- Remove any clutter from around mechanical systems mentioned above.
- Close and lock all windows.
- Close fireplace dampers and glass doors.
- Remove any obstructions such as screens from fireplace areas.
- Make a list of existing problems in your home including drafty areas, rooms that are too cold or too hot, and condensation on windows.
- Be prepared to answer basic questions about your home, such as the average temperature settings during winter and summer months.
